Literacy

In literacy, we have been learning about predictions and connections to stories, as well as how to use the pictures to help understand the story. In writing, we have been learning about opinion writing. We talk about stating an opinion and then giving a reason for that opinion. We are also working on putting spaces between our words, and using proper capitalization and punctuation.


Math


